**Updated information related to SIL for Placer County Board of Supervisors (date correction) and state and congressional offices affected by the redistricting.**

The June 7, 2022 Statewide Direct Primary Election has begun for most offices. Signature in Lieu petitions will be made available for candidates filing for offices with a mandatory filing fee as to reduce or eliminate that fee. Signature in Lieu petitions will be available from the Placer County Elections Office beginning January 3, 2022 for all offices, with the exception of the office of Placer County Supervisor. Candidates interested in obtaining Signature in Lieu petitions for the office of Placer County Supervisor may do so beginning January 12, 2022.

Signature in Lieu petitions may be circulated among registered voters until February 9, 2022. By collecting voters' signatures on the petition, the candidate may cover all or part of the filing fee.

For all other offices up at the Statewide Direct Primary Election, candidate filing begins on February 14, 2022. The Elections Office will be closed on President's Day, February 21, 2022. Candidate filing closes March 11, 2022 at 5 PM. If an incumbent fails to file during this time period, candidate filing will extend for any candidate except the incumbent and end on March 16, 2022 at 5 PM. If an incumbent files there will not be an extension of candidate filing for that office.

Candidates may pick up the Signature in Lieu petitions and nomination documents at the Placer County Elections Office, located at 2956 Richardson Drive in Auburn. Hours of operation are 8 AM to 5 PM, Monday through Friday excluding holidays. Placer County Elections Office will be offering remote filing for candidates who are unable to visit the

elections office. Appointments to file nomination paperwork in our office or remotely can be made by visiting our website, by submitting an email request, or by phone. All candidate filing documents with **original signatures** must be received in our office on or before the close of candidate filing, whether by mail or in person to be included on the ballot for the June 7, 2022 Statewide Direct Primary Election. Placer County Elections Office will hold a candidate workshop to review the requirements for running for public office, which offices are up for election and the basics of running a political campaign. The workshop will be conducted at the Placer County Assessor's Confluence Meeting Room located at 2980 Richardson Drive in Auburn from 10 AM to on February 19, 2022.1 PM
