The last day to register to vote and receive a ballot and Voter Information Guide by mail for the June 7, 2022, Statewide Direct Primary Election is May 23, 2022. Registration forms may be picked up at our Elections Office or any Department of Motor Vehicles, post office, and library in Placer County. Registration forms may also be accessed online at registertovote.ca.gov. To further assist Placer County voters, voter registration forms will be placed outside the Placer County Elections Office entrance at 2956 Richardson Drive in Auburn, on May 23, 2022, until 12 AM (midnight). Completed registration forms will be processed the next morning. In addition, completed registration forms can be placed in the secure, drive-up drop-off box located in front of the Elections Office only if it's uncovered.

Voters who have missed the registration deadline may access Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) in California. Under this law, eligible voters who missed the 15-day registration deadline can come to the Elections Office on or before Election Day, or to their polling place on Election Day, to conditionally register to vote and cast a ballot.

The Elections Office is located at 2956 Richardson Drive. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8 AM to 5 PM. Election Day hours are 7 AM to 8 PM. The Elections Office will be open the two weekends prior to the June 7, 2022, Statewide Direct Primary Election (May 28 and 29 & June 4 and 5) from 9 AM to 4 PM, and on Memorial Day, May 31, from 9 AM to 4 PM. Voters may call 530-886-5650 or toll-free in California, 1-800-824-8683, with questions regarding the upcoming election. Elections staff will be available to issue replacement vote by mail ballots over the counter.

If you have interacted recently with the DMV, your voter registration information may have been inadvertently changed. It is important to confirm your voter status, political

party preference, address, and all other pertinent information to make sure you are still registered correctly. Check your status at voterstatus.sos.ca.gov.

Voters may find out if they are registered to vote, register to vote, find their polling place, and find election results on our website at www.placercountyelections.gov.
