Candidates for judicial offices are required to file a Declaration of Intention prior to the candidate-filing period. The first day the Declaration of Intention may be issued is October 28, 2019. The last day to file the Declaration of Intention is November 6, 2019. If an incumbent fails to file, the deadline for that office extends until November 11, 2019 for individuals other than the incumbent. Judicial candidates must file the Declaration of Intention prior to filing for office in order to appear on the ballot.

Candidate filing begins November 11, 2019 and continues through December 6, 2019. If an incumbent fails to file during this time period, candidate filing will extend 5 days for any candidate except the incumbent and end on December 11, 2019. When the incumbent files there will not be an extension of candidate filing for that office.

Judicial candidates can pick up the Declaration of Intention at the Placer County Elections Office, located at 2956 Richardson Drive in Auburn. Hours of operation are 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. The Elections Office will be open on November 11, 2019 (Veteran's Day) from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
